

Roster of Physics Departments with Enrollment and Degree Data, 2009

Results from the 2009 Survey of Enrollments and Degrees

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This roster contains detailed data from the annual Survey of Enrollments and Degrees. The survey was conducted in the fall of the 2009-10 academic year and covers all degree-granting physics departments in the United States.

The number of physics bachelor's granted continues to climb, with 5,908 degrees in the class of 2009. As physics undergraduate enrollments continue to increase, bachelor's production will also see increases. PhD's are also on the rise with 1,554 conferred in the class of 2009.
